How do I get started?

You don't need to do anything to get started. Your doctor will contact us directly.

What happens next?

One of our network pharmacies will call you to start therapy, arrange shipment, and help you manage your condition at no extra charge. Patient care teams are available from 8 am to 8 pm Eastern Time, Monday–Friday.

Personalized Support

You will get personal support for your therapy. After-hours care from the pharmacist can help you 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Care teams will schedule your therapy and give you support to be sure you get the most from your medication. They can answer questions about how to take your medication or help with managing side effects. They will help you with your benefit and financial support if those services are available.

Convenient Dispensing and Delivery

The pharmacy will ship your medication to you or your doctor, depending on who is administering the drug. If your doctor administers your medication in the office, it will be shipped to your doctor. If you administer the medication yourself, it will be shipped to you at the address you provide in private packaging that doesn't indicate what is in the box.
